NCFI Polyurethanes and the NCFI GOLD STAR CONTRACTOR indicated on the reverse side of this form, enter into the following agreement, which is supplemental to the NCFI GOLD STAR CERTIFIED INSULATION CONTRACTOR AGREEMENT, for the purpose of providing the building owner, as described on the reverse side of this form (OWNER), a Three Year Warranty.

NCFI and NCFI GOLD STAR CONTRACTOR agree to the following:

- (1) Account Balance must be current prior to issuance of any warranty documents.
- (2) NCFI GOLD STAR CONTRACTOR agrees to inspect the warranted wall application at the completion of the spray foam application. NCFI GOLD STAR APPLICATOR will be responsible for correcting any and all workmanship defects discovered as a result of this inspection, notwithstanding the responsibilities listed below. Gold Star contractor will provide NCFI with pictures and field checklist prior to issuance of warranty.
- (3) In the event repairs covered under the WARRANTY AGREEMENT are needed after NCFI specifications have been followed, NCFI will provide the required foam materials to the NCFI GOLD STAR CONTRACTOR. NCFI GOLD STAR CONTRACTOR will provide tools and labor needed to complete repairs.
- (4) Non-Gold Star applicators bidding a job with NCFI Chemicals requiring a warranty must have a pre-application job inspection by an NCFI Tech Rep to inspect contractor's equipment, observe application of closed cell SPF, and demonstrate of proper use of PPE. This job inspection requires a \$500 inspection fee plus all travel expenses by the NCFI Representative. Contractor agrees to section (3) above.
- (5) If either party is notified of a warranty claim, it shall promptly notify the other and arrange the necessary inspections.
- (6) The obligations of NCFI and NCFI GOLD STAR CONTRACTOR contained in this agreement shall survive the termination of the NCFI GOLD STAR CERTIFIED INSULATION CONTRACTOR AGREEMENT.
- (7) ABAA inspectors and inspections do not cover the requirements for job site inspections by NCFI personnel.
